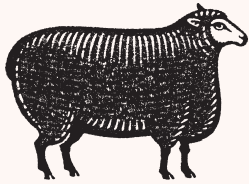


LE GRAND NOIR



SYRAH

LA GUITARE ÉLÈCTRIQUE

VINEYARD NOTES

Years of experience have allowed us to identify those Languedoc vineyards, where the Syrah grape displays its most intense characters: *La Livinière*, *Caunes Minervois* and *Aigues Vives*.

WINEMAKING NOTES

Careful cellar handling including cool fermentation with shorter maceration to retain fruit characters and hotter more traditional fermentations with longer maceration to obtain more structure. 20% of the wine has been oaked for 6 months using French oak barrels.

TASTING NOTES

Dark red purple colour, intense aromas of black olive, black pepper with a touch of spice. Soft tannins balanced with a good acidity with lingering blackcurrant flavours combined with subtle vanilla.

FOOD STYLE

To accompany *pasta dishes*, *red meat* and *mildly spiced dishes* are a perfect match.
